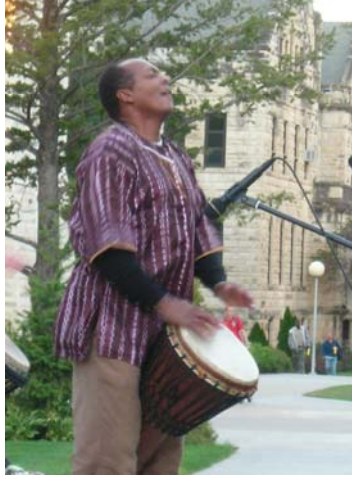


**Wonder Workshop Children's Museum

Drumming helps us to focus and it ask us to use discipline as a tool to accomplish our goals. Drumming is a great way for individuals to experience the success of team work by playing with others.
